

Bucklin Point Green Energy

On July 18th, the Narragansett Bay Commission (NBC) generously hosted a NEBRA tour of the upgraded anaerobic digestion and planned combined heat and power (CH systems at the Bucklin Point WWTF. Barry Wenskowicz led the tour.

Wenskowicz estimates that off-site solids management - landfill disposal and incineration – generate the WWTF's largest proportions – about 2/3 – of greenhouse gas emissions, much in the forms of methane and nitrous oxide. To address that, an to help meet NBC's aggressive goal of achieving 100% sustainable electricity generation, the Bucklin Point facility is installing CHP to fully utilize the biogas produc in the anaerobic digesters....
