## Biosolids Down & Up in Western New York

On May 6, 2016, a lower cou in Niagara Falls, NY upheld t Town of Wheatfield's ban on use of biosolids. Sustainable BioElectric LLC, a quasar energy group company, had petitioned the court to annul tordinance.

But, one month later, on June

9th, the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets (NYSDAM) ordered Wheatfield not to enforce its ordinance in agricultural districts, because it unreasonable restricts a local farm's operation in violation of the state's "right-to-farm" law. NYSDAM stated that "the Town has not demonstrated that the public health or safety is threaten by the farm operation's land application of Equate biosolids on land used for crop production."

Nate Carr, NY Manager for quasar (photo above) notes that quasar is pleased with the NYSDAM ruling and is considering next steps regarding the court's decision.

Wheatfield has until July 9th to confirm with NYSDAM that the local ban on biosolids  $\iota$  "will not be imposed on the farm operation." However, the town has hired a law firm  $\iota$  consider contesting NYSDAM's order. More...



A revised standard for molybdenum in biosolids applied to s in Massachusetts (MA) will likely take effect later this year. June 3rd, the MA Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) announced the proposed change to the "sludge

and septage" regulations (310 CMR 32.00).

A public hearing on this and other MassDEP regulatory changes proposed under Governor Charlie Baker's regulatory reform initiative (Executive Order 562) will be hel Monday, June 27th, 10 am - Noon, at the MassDEP offices in Boston. Comments are due by July 13, 2016.
